### **SECTION 1:**

## **WELCOMING TOUR OF THE ALLIANCE**

**Building presentation and french conversation – Y7 to Y12 / All levels**

**This workshop will help your students to discover the name of the room in a building and practice french conversation with a french native speaker**

- After discovering and naming the different places of the alliance, hall, welcome desk, office, classroom, library, students spread in small groups will meet a french native teacher for an open conversation.
- It's a good opportunity for the student to practice in a real situation, how to introduce, how to talk about habits, hobbies.
- They will also discover about francophonie and New Caledonia.
- Then we will take together a french morning tea, using expressions like “voulez-vous un pain au chocolat ?” “oui merci avec plaisir, non merci je préfère un croissant”, “ce jus de fruit est très bon”.

## SECTION 2

# LANGUAGE ORIENTED



### Pronunciation : l'alphabet et les voyelles

**Y7 to Y10 / Level of students: A1**

**This workshop will help your students get a good start on basic sound patterns in French through pronunciation games.**

Students will gain an understanding of the French alphabet and vowel system. On a practical level, they will be able to ask about and spell their name; if you choose the longer workshops, they will further learn about theory and differentiate between the many sounds of the letter -E, and the difference between -OU (ex: la roue) and -U (ex: la rue).

The last part of the workshop is dedicated to a very popular French spelling game called "Le Pendu" where students will work in teams to guess about French cultural highlights (e.g. la Tour Eiffel, Victor Hugo, etc).

**1h - 1h30 - 2h**

### Le questionnaire : faisons connaissance

**Y7 to Y10 / Level of students: A1/A2**

**This workshop is designed to revise basic introductions by focusing on the grammatical structures to ask questions in French.**

- Through language games, students will first practise forming basic open questions (name, age, nationality...) in the "tu" and "vous" persons, as well as revise the key verbs ETRE, AVOIR and S'APPELER, and finally brush up on their knowledge of numbers . They will then create their own questionnaire re-using all of the above grammar points, and interact with native staff members of Alliance Française to fill it out.
- More advanced groups will also get the opportunity to go over the grammatical structures to ask

more independent closed YES/NO questions in their questionnaire.

### Les 7 familles : à vous de jouer !

**Y7 to Y10 / Level of students: A1/A2**

**This workshop is designed to revise the vocabulary and grammar around the topic of family.**

Students will gain confidence in grammatical gender patterns (mon/ma, le/la, etc) and be able to describe their own family tree. The last part of the workshop is dedicated to discovering the very popular French card game "Les 7 familles" where students will be able to re-use their knowledge orally while playing in small groups, with the added bonus of finding out about the traditional costumes of 7 regions of France.

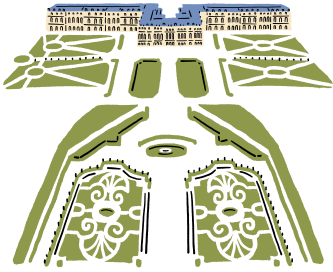
### Preparation for the DELF Junior/Scolaire exams

**Y11 to Y12 / Level of students: A2/B1**

**This workshop is designed to prepare students for the DELF A2-B1 Exams and focuses on the speaking and writing skills to be assessed.**

- Students will become familiar with the format of the exam and will be guided to develop effective strategies for the speaking and writing tasks by observing and analysing past papers and model answers. They will then get opportunities to try out these new strategies and gain confidence in the safe environment of informal mock tasks, individually and/or in small groups, and receive feedback to take home as a basis for further training.
- The DELF B1 diploma allows students to take part in study exchanges with French universities without further language testing required.

## SECTION 3 HISTORY



### Bienvenue à Versailles – Y5&6

#### Cultural workshop before Bastille Day (July 14)

**This workshop is aimed at enabling young learners to discover the French monarchy at the time of Versailles through a range of fun and interactive language games and craft activities.**

Students will first learn some basic key vocabulary related to the monarchy, and they will then play with the vocabulary for colours in French, before combining these two learning topics in a short writing task. The final activity is about craft and recapping on colours: colouring King Louis XIV and making your own crown!

### Bienvenue à Versailles - Y9&10

2h

**This workshop is aimed at enabling students to discover the French monarchy at the time of Versailles through a range of fun and interactive language games and craft activities.**

- Students will first learn some key vocabulary about the monarchy, and they will then work on the family tree of King Louis XIV to gain an understanding of French History and the main characters around the time of Versailles. This will also enable them to revise topical vocabulary about family. Students will then have the opportunity to link their knowledge about the French monarchy to the current British monarchy. The workshop concludes with a quiz to recap on the cultural contents of the session.
- In the longer version of the workshop, we offer team craft activities for the students to build their own Versailles castle, on paper and/or online!

2h – 3h

### A la rencontre des soldats de la Première Guerre Mondiale

Y9 to Y10

- This workshop is designed to allow students to connect with History by giving them an opportunity for fun, hands-on activities around the international context of World War 1. It is also aimed at challenging the idea that French is only used in French class!
- Students will get to know the many international soldiers involved in World War 1 and identify the corps they belonged to. In the longer version of the workshop, they will further gain knowledge in the battles they took part in.
- The aim is to bring this crucial part of the world's History closer to the students, by enabling them to be active learners and make sense of a topic they may otherwise see as distant and foreign.

1h - 2h

### Première Guerre Mondiale : un saut dans le passé

Y11 to Y12

- This workshop is designed to allow students to connect with History by giving them an opportunity for fun, hands-on activities around the international context of World War 1. It is also aimed at challenging the idea that French is only used in French class!
- Students will gain insight into the triggers of World War 1, how alliances formed and events subsequently unfolded. In the longer version of the workshop, they will further become familiar with the daily lives of the soldiers in the trenches.
- The aim is to bring this crucial part of the world's History closer to the students, by enabling them to be active learners and make sense of a topic they may otherwise see as distant and foreign.

## SECTION 4 CULTURE



### Découverte culturelle : La francophonie

Y11 to Y12

- This workshop is designed to introduce the concept of "francophonie" and explore the Pacific.
- Starting off with a speaking activity, students will be challenged to learn about the "francophonie" and the "Organisation Internationale de la Francophonie". Then, using official documentation from the OIF, they will enjoy active reading by investigating New-Caledonia and some francophone islands such as Vanuatu or Wallis et Futuna.

### Découverte culturelle : La France des régions

Y11 to Y12

- In this workshop, students will learn about the "other France", the hidden and secretive France that natives know about.
- Students will become more familiar with the "other France", the one that is not shown in magazines. They will learn more about secret places such as Les catacombes de Paris, Le Palais idéal de facteur cheval, le musée Picassiette, or the overseas territories.

### Atelier Lunch Quiche Lorraine

Y8 to Y10

Students will discover a dish typical of everyday French food: the "la quiche lorraine".

- The students will discover the ingredients in French and the recipe. They will be able to make their own quiche themselves and taste it.

## SECTION 7 EVENTS



**We offer workshops adapted to the different times of the year.**

### **EASTER – Y4 to Y5 All levels**

This workshop will be adapted to the students' age group and will allow them to discover the vocabulary around this holiday while having fun. It will end with the traditional egg hunt.

### **ANZAC DAY – Y5 to Y10 All levels**

**1h-2h**

This workshop will allow participants to review the course of the First and Second World Wars in a playful way while learning the appropriate vocabulary.

### **CHRISTMAS – Y4 to Y5 All levels**

**2h**

This workshop will be adapted to the students' age group and will allow them to discover the vocabulary around this holiday while having fun.

### **King's Birthday – Y5 to Y8 All levels**

**1h-2h**

This workshop allows you to discover the famous kings and queens of France as well as those of England while learning appropriate vocabulary.

### **Labour Day – Y5 to Y8 All levels**

**2h**

This workshop allows you to discover the vocabulary of professions in French in a playful way using mime.

### **Seasons – Y1 to Y8 All levels**

**1h-2h**

This workshop allows you to discover the vocabulary of the different seasons and is suitable for all times of the year. The focus will be on the current season with visual arts activities.

### **Halloween – Y1 to Y8 All levels**

**1h-2h**

This workshop will introduce the theme of Halloween with craft activities and the learning of new vocabulary related to this holiday.

## **SECTION 8**

### **VIRTUAL REALITY**

**Our 8 virtual reality headsets allow us to offer a more playful learning of French and to generate more interest from the students. We can lead workshops for up to 16 students by forming 2 groups.**

**The headsets are used as educational tools and allow for the introduction of concepts and vocabulary.**

#### **Discovery of France – Y4 to Y8 All levels**

This workshop will immerse the students in France, and they will discover its capital with Notre Dame de Paris, and they will fly over the Alps.

#### **At the heart of the world wars**

**Y6 to Y10 All levels**

This workshop will allow participants to review the course of the First and Second World Wars in a playful way while learning the appropriate vocabulary.

**1h30-2h**

#### **The Environment**

**Y4 to Y7 All levels**

This workshop allows students to become aware of the environment by developing critical thinking about their carbon footprint and the use of plastic.

#### **Space**

**Y4 to Y8 All levels**

This workshop allows you to discover the wonderful landscapes of Mars and the action of satellites around the Earth. Students will learn the vocabulary of planets and aerospace.
